

Mississippi Timber Price Report

3rd Quarter 2018



The Mississippi Timber Price Report provides a picture of timber market activity across the state showing regional and statewide stumpage prices for common forest products. This report should only be used as a guide to help individuals monitor timber market trends. The average price should not be applied as fair market value for a specific timber sale because many variables influence actual prices each landowner will receive. How are prices obtained? This report used data from 89 timber sales conducted and reported across Mississippi during the 3rd quarter of 2018. Reporters include forest product companies, logging contractors, consulting foresters, landowners, and other natural resource professionals.

Price Trends

The 3rd quarter statewide stumpage prices for pine products are located in Table 1. Pine products reported include pine poles, sawtimber, plylogs, chip-n-saw, topwood, and pulpwood. Hardwood products include oak sawtimber, mixed hardwood sawtimber, pulpwood, and crossties (Table 2). We have included low and high prices to indicate differences landowners could expect to receive. The graphs reflect 10-year statewide average price trends.

The oversupply issue continues to influence timber prices in Mississippi and will continue to impact prices for an extended time period. Dry weather during much of the 3rd quarter also negatively impacted statewide stumpage prices. Compared to the 2nd quarter of 2018, statewide average prices declined for all species and product classes except hardwood pulpwood which increased. Pine pulpwood faced a 35% decrease this quarter. However, as expected, regional differences were noticed for each species/product class with some regions seeing increased prices while other regions decreased.

Prices are expected to remain relatively stable headed into the 4th Quarter, with slight increases for some species/product classes and slight decreases for others. Prices in north Mississippi, particularly pulpwood will continue to suffer because of oversupply and reduced demand in the area.






